

A quick guide to setting up your integration

1. **Contact your Yardi Account Manager** and ask to have the PetScreening vendor add-on package loaded to your interface database

*PetScreening doesn't automatically show in your database of vendor interfaces until ILS Guest Card Plv18, so your Yardi Account Manager will need to add the PetScreening vendor package for you all. Once PetScreening is visible in your database, you can access PetScreening's interface in the ILS Guest Card settings: **Interfaces > Configuration > Review Interface Vendors > ILS Guest Card > PetScreening***

2. **Create a property list named 'PetScreening list'**. Include all properties that will use PetScreening.

3. **Use Bulk Property interface configuration** to add PetScreening to all properties in the PetScreening List.

You can access this function by going to **Interfaces > Configuration > Bulk Property Interface Configuration**. Alternatively, you can manually add PetScreening to all properties: Please review property → Click on Functions → Interface Configuration → ILS Guest Card and make sure PetScreening is selected

4. **If you use an existing ILS Interface security group, verify the security group has the following permissions: (NOTE: You can check the permissions by going to the Administration Menu and clicking on Set Permissions.)**

Interfaces: Web Service – Common Data – Read/Write

Interfaces: Web Service – ILS/Guest Card (Core and Other) – Read/Write

Interfaces: Web Service – Resident Data – Read/Write

Interfaces: Web Service – Lease Renewal – Read/Write

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If you do not have an existing ILS Interface security group, add an ILS Guest Card Interface group, and select the menu set RES. You can create a new group by clicking on Add Groups from the Administration menu. After the group is added, please go to Set Permissions, and set all permissions to Most Restrictive. **Lastly, assign the Read/Write permissions similar to the list above.**

5. Manually create a Petscreening Agent with the following information.

Code: petscree	Property List: (use property list from Step 2)
Last name: petscreening	Username: petscreening
Group: (select group from Step 4)	Password: (Secure Password)

Go to Privilege tab > select Interface User

6. Send PetScreening your Yardi credentials. Below is an **example** of what we'll need.

ILS Guest Card Options

Import & Export Resident/ Guest Activity Options

- Use country code in Import/Export – Leave unchecked
- Use Chatlogs – Leave unchecked

Export Resident/ Guest Activity Options

- Include only residents/guests with activity in the last 90 days
 - Once your account is live, change this setting to 7 days
- Schema Version (ILS export only) – 4.0
- Use floor plan data – Leave unchecked
- Export all guest cards, ignore interface association – Check This Box
- Export federal identification number – Leave Unchecked

All other options can be ignored. Choose “Save” at the bottom left of the prompt.

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Yardi PDF Notes Configuration

Here is what needs to be configured inside Yardi for the PDF notes to pass on to prospects and tenants.

ILS Guest Card interface

1. Configure "PetScreening" under the Administration menu > System > Attachment Types. Ensure the following types are configured:
 - a. Tenant - PetScreening
2. Under the **Petscreening Interface Configuration**, please ensure that "**Petscreening**" is present under the boxes for both **Tenant AND Prospect** Import/Export Attachment Types.
3. Under the Common Data Configuration for PetScreening, please ensure the following Import/Export Attachment Types are present:
 - a. Tenant - Petscreening
